**NEW IMMUNIZATION MANDATED FOR MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL
STUDENTS TO ENROLL IN SCHOOL!**

Whooping cough (Pertussis) has been widespread in California during 2010 with many becoming seriously ill. A new California Law (Assembly Bill 354) mandates that all students entering grades 7th to 12th grades in California must show proof of a recent Pertussis immunization to enroll in school next year. Your student will need to show proof of immunization to enroll in middle or high school at spring registration.

For the 2011-12 school year all students entering 7th through 12th grades will need proof of a Pertussis booster shot also called a "Tdap" (Tetanus toxoid, reduced diphtheria toxoid and acellular pertussis vaccine) before starting school. This requirement:

- Begins July 1, 2011 (but will be required for early spring registration)
- Can be met by receiving one dose of "Tdap" vaccine on or after the 7th birthday.
- Applies to all students in public and private schools.
- Does not affect students enrolled in summer school.
- The law allows an exemption for physician verified medical conditions or a statement of personal belief.

We encourage all students who will be attending middle and high school next fall to visit a medical provider or the Fresno County Health Department to get your whooping cough shot now.

If your student has already obtained the Pertussis booster please bring a copy of your student's immunization card to the school health office to update your student's health record. More information on this law can be obtained from:

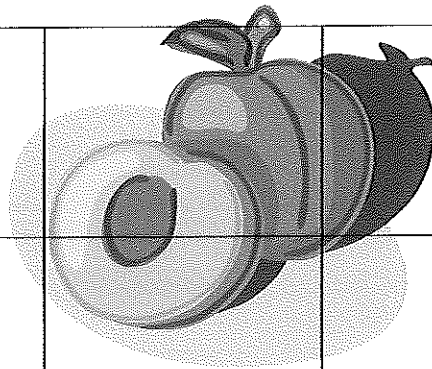

They may be given what I have on hand, and you will be billed accordingly.
4. Please complete the lunch ticket order form entirely. Name, grade, # of lunches etc. Please make the checks payable to Culinary Delights, not to O.L.V.
5. Milk and juice tickets can also be purchased through the lunch program. A milk or juice ticket is good for 20 milks, or 20 juices. The cost is \$10.00 each. The drinks can be purchased day by day, they are \$.60 each.
6. I do not have time to heat up any food that a child has brought from home. Absolutely no exceptions.
7. There is a \$25.00 service charge on all return checks. If you have a check that is returned and it happens a second time I will have to place you on a cash only basis.

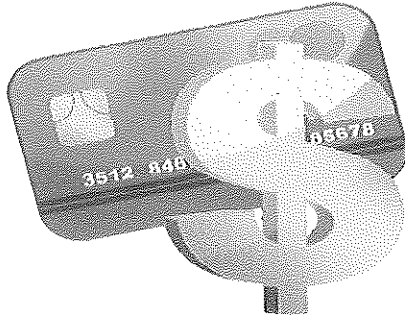

If you already have a laptop, or want to purchase a different brand, you need to verify that it meets the following **minimum requirements**:

- Operating system: Windows XP pro, Windows Vista Business or Ultimate, Windows 7 Professional or Ultimate. (Home versions of windows do NOT have the file-sharing capabilities necessary and will not be allowed)
- Microsoft Office XP or later, with Word, PowerPoint & Excel installed
- 1 GB RAM (or more)
- 802.11b Wireless Network Adaptor, preferably internal wireless
- 80 GB or larger hard drive
- Carrying case

**If you are using a Mac, you must be able to boot to a windows operating system listed above*

Some recommendations: a smaller laptop is better (14-15"). Battery life is an important factor, be sure the battery will last at least 3 – 5 hours without being plugged in.

Violin Classes 2011-2012

For the third year Our Lady of Victory is continuing to offer students the opportunity to start violin class (*) in the spring semester! We are also opening up registration to preschool and kindergarten. (**) Violin students will get a private lesson with Mr. Shearen and a group class every week. The group class takes place from 2:15-3:00pm on Thursday during the Fine Arts period. The private lessons are tentatively scheduled for Tuesdays. The fee for violin class is \$25 per week, payable to OLV. The other costs associated with violin class are:

- Violin rental \$20.00-\$30.00 per month
- Instrument insurance (optional) \$3.00-\$9.00 per month (based on value of violin)
- Suzuki Violin Method Book 1 \$19.95 (includes CD)
- Rosin \$6.95-12.95
- Shoulder rest (recommended) \$24.95(1/10-1/2 size violins)
\$26.95(3/4-4/4 size violins)

**Students participating in violin classes will act & behave in the manner expected of an OLV student in a learning environment. Students who disrupt class can expect to have their parent/guardian notified immediately, during class, of their disruptive behavior. Continued disruptions will result in the student being sent to the office and their parent/guardian notified of the students actions. A parent conference may be held to discuss the students actions with the principal with the student potentially being removed from violin classes altogether.*

OLV takes the learning environment very seriously and will not tolerate any student who distracts, disrupts or inhibits any other students ability to focus and learn.

***Parents of preschool and kindergarten student will need to be present at the private lesson. The parent will need to be working with their children to ensure the student learns the proper techniques. The Suzuki Method being used by Mr. Shearen is known as the "mother tongue" technique.
